Why become a Registered Apprentice?

Registered Apprenticeships offer individuals the opportunity to receive a salary while gaining on-the-job experience and gaining technical instruction and support in the classroom. As an apprentice you will not just be training for a job, you will be establishing a robust career pathway for yourself. CHW Certificate holders or students currently enrolled at an accredited Minnesota college or University in a Community Health Worker Certificate Program are eligible to become an apprentice at a Registered Apprenticeship Site.
