Rock County, Minnesota

- 18 Counties in Southwest Minnesota region identified as having little or no access to dental care.
- Rock County ranked #2 in the state with the least dental care access.
- 1 dentist serving Rock County-population 9,687 (Average ratio: 1 per 2,272 for small or rural communities. 1 per 3,938 for rural or isolated communities.)
